


Muscatine County Conservation

We are now accepting Online Reservations for:

- Cabins at Deep Lakes Park
- Saulsbury Lodge at Saulsbury
- Campsites at Saulsbury Bridge Recreation Area's Main Campground
- Picnic Shelters at Discovery, Saulsbury, & Jack Shuger
- 1. Scan the QR Code on the top right.
 - a. Open the camera on your smartphone and focus on the QR Code.
 - b. Then click on the "Open in web browser" that pops up.
- 2. OR Visit: MyCountyParks.com/county/muscatine
 - a. Click on Facilities
 - b. In the Facility Type box, choose what you wish to reserve.
 - c. You may also enter the date(s) you are looking for under "Choose your Dates."
 - d. When you get to the calendar, click on the first day of your stay and drag through the calendar to select all the <u>nights</u> you want to stay, clicking again on the last day.
 - i. For a shelter reservation you would just click one day
 - ii. Cabins must be reserved at least 2-days in a row (max 14)
 - iii. Camping reservations have a max of 14 days (in any one spot)
 - Wednesdays are still free!
 - iv. Saulsbury Lodge is day use only (with some exceptions)
 - 1. Youth/conservation groups should contact us for a \$30 discount
 - 2. Weddings/receptions must reserve 3-days and pay the extra \$40 wedding reception fee \$370
 - e. Click search then scroll down to see all the available options.
 - f. You can search a lot of different ways play around and see what works best for you.
 - g. Find the amenity you want to reserve, click on it and add your dates.
 - i. Double check everything site, dates, price, # of nights...
 - ii. If happy, click "Checkout"
 - iii. Fill out required information and accept waivers
 - iv. Complete billing information and list any special needs
 - v. Click Confirm & Pay
 - h. Mark your calendars for you next Outdoor Adventure in Muscatine County!





- ONLY sites in the SAULSBURY MAIN CAMPGROUND can be reserved online
- Most reservations have to be made at least 3-days in advance of your stay.
- Rangers will post orange "Reserved" cards in the camp post for reservations
- Reservations can be made in advance: a year for campsites and two years for: Cabins, Lodge, & Shelters.
- There is a \$4 fee added to maintain the MyCountyParks.com website
- All sales are final, refunds are not given.
- The MyCountyParks.com website features all 99 Iowa Counties. Not all conduct e-commerce on the site, but there are quite a few.
